### GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

- **Tuesday, May 16, 2017**

## WHO CAN BE A POLL WORKER?

To be a poll worker, you must be:

- At least 18 years old
- A California resident
- A United States citizen registered to vote or a legal permanent resident
- Able to speak, read, and write English or be bilingual (read/speak the second language)
- Recruited through the Election Division

## WHAT ARE THE RESPONSIBILITIES?

- Serve on Election Day 6:00 a.m. - 9:30 p.m.
- Assist with setting up the polling place
- Process voters and provide support
- Assist with closing the poll and packing supplies

\*You must serve all day on Election Day to receive a stipend.

## HOW MUCH WILL I GET PAID?

### INSPECTORS

- \$150 for serving on Election Day\*
- \$50 for picking up and dropping off Election Day Supplies\*
- \$40 for attending mandatory poll worker training\*

### CLERKS

- \$100 for serving on Election Day\*
- \$40 for attending mandatory poll worker training\*
